Our Program

The SUD Recovery Services Program is a licensed 8-bed residential detox unit for individuals who are homeless addressing issues with substance use. The program has a projected length of stay of 5-7 days.



Voluntary

For persons experiencing homelessness seeking assistance with substance use treatment. Our guests are free to leave our facility at any point in their stay. 6160 is not a locked down facility.



Eligibility

Adults only. HHSC eligibility criteria is followed. Last use must be within 72 hours to qualify for detox.



Services

- Confidential screenings.
- Monitoring and managing physical withdrawal symptoms.
- Assisting individuals in recovery from substance abuse by increasing self-awareness and the ability to manage difficulties resulting from substance use.
- Addressing the specific recovery needs of both adult men and women.
- Providing case management and referrals to the appropriate level of care.
- Individual counseling and group therapy available.
- Establishing links to natural supports in the community.



Referrals

Referral sources include but are not limited to: Outreach Screening Assessment and Referral (OSAR) screening referrals, substance use service agencies, hospitals, community partners, and internal referrals made by Harris Center staff. Special considerations should be noted by referral source.
