PROGRAM SPOTLIGHTS



Early Childhood Intervention (ECI)

Services designed to assist parents in addressing the needs of children under the age of three with delayed development and/or certain medical diagnoses which will result in delayed development. Services offered include evaluation and assessment, occupational and physical therapy, speech-language therapy, service coordination, family counseling and education and developmental services. Services are provided in child's home or community settings (daycare, foster parent, grandparent, etc.).

Mobile Crisis Outreach Team Rapid Response

The Mobile Crisis Outreach Rapid Response Team partnered with the Crisis Call Diversion (CCD) program and the Houston Police Department to automatically dispatch mental health clinicians as an alternative response to law enforcement for non-violent, non-criminal calls for service to 911 involving a mental health concern and could not be diverted by CCD over the phone. Program was initiated as a Pilot in March 2021 and is funded through the City of Houston.
